Sid: Hello, Sid Roth here with Mike Shreve.

Welcome to my world, where it's naturally supernatural.

There is a way to rescue your children that are
behind enemy lines, and many of your children are.

It's a supernatural way, and I love it.

I've been waiting a long time for something like this.

I have Mike Shreve here. Mike, you've been a guest before,
and for those who missed your show,

you came out of being an instructor of yoga
at four universities, some 400 hundred students.

You had a supernatural encounter with Jesus,
and what did you tell your students then?

Mike: I went back to all of my yoga classes and told them
that unknowingly I had misled them,
and that Jesus really was the only way.

The way my salvation happened was incredible.

I won't go into detail, because our focus is not that,
but the Tampa Tribune newspaper did an article about me,
and I thought it would increase my class attendance.

Instead, it alerted a prayer group locally to pray for me.

One of the members of that prayer group

happened to be a former yoga student himself,

who picked me up hitchhiking about a month later,
and led me to the Lord.

The way it all fit together is just absolutely miraculous.

Sid: Did many of your students then become believers in Jesus?

Mike: Almost all of my main students became Christians.

A month or two ago, I received an email from a young lady
who was in the first class where I announced my salvation.

She left college and joined a Christian community
out in California, and 37 years later emails me

and tells me "Thank you for leading me to Jesus."

Sid: Mike, I have to tell you,

I am so excited about this book of yours
that allows us to rescue our children and grandchildren
that are behind enemy lines.

It's called "God's Promises For Your Children."

I can tell you, personally I read one of these promises
for my children and grandchildren every single day,
and everyone could and should be doing that.

But you didn't even want to get married!

Why did you change your mind?

Mike: Well, God spoke to me.

In the beginning of my walk with God,

I received a revelation from God where He told me not to marry.

He never told me that was a permanent institution,

but He told me to just put that on the shelf.

So I made a covenant with God

that I would never marry until He told me it was time

and told me the person. Now that was around 1971.

Well, it was not until 1989 that He actually spoke to me,

and by then I was wondering if He'd forgotten our arrangement.

But when He spoke to me audibly,

He woke me up one morning and He told me

that He had sent me an unspeakable gift.

That was His words concerning my wife.

She had been my administrative assistant for three years,

but I had not thought about marriage,

because I thought God wanted me to remain single

and devoted to ministry entirely.

But He also told me that I would have an attractive son,

that I would be married to Elizabeth,

who is a wonderful woman of God,

and I would have an attractive son. That was it.

I went over and explained to her

that God had just spoken to me, and she said

"Well I've known that for ten years.

He spoke to me ten years ago." But she never told me.

So we set the date a few weeks later and got married.

Sid: But then, when you got married,

you couldn't have any children.

Mike: Yes, the doctors said that it was impossible

for us to have children.

Sid: But God spoke to you about a son!

Mike: Yes, so we held onto that living word promise.

See, the Bible talks about warring spiritually

with prophecies that are spoken over us.

You can take a word that you get from God

and fight against all the assaults of doubts

and fears that come against your mind.

Not only did we have to implement faith

in that prophetic word to even have a child,

then when he was born,

he went through a very traumatic birth

that should have left him severely damaged mentally.

Sid: You have a friend who has a similar case,

where he would be mentally retarded.

Mike: What happened is he laid in the birth canal

for an excessive amount of time.

They broke my wife's water,

she had a very lengthy time of delivery.

I think it was around 40 hours she was in labor.

They broke her water, and then he laid in the birth canal

and should have suffered oxygen deprivation,

according to them.

They were expecting him to be mentally damaged.

But quite the contrary, he doesn't even

hardly apply himself and can get straight A's.
Sid: He's got a photographic memory.
Mike: I'm jealous.
Sid: I want him to rub a little on me. No, I'm just teasing.
Mike: It's amazing. I believe the reason that happened
is because of what we'll be talking about.
The revelation God gave me
is that there are specific promises in God's word
that He has given us for our seed.
There are specifically 65 things that God says
He will do for my son, for my daughter
because of my walk with Him.
One of them is Proverbs 11:21, where it says
"Though hand join in hand, the wicked shall not go unpunished,
but the seed of the righteous shall be delivered."
That's the kind of promise we can claim
over this traumatic birth situation.
Sid: And this is not a one time occurrence.
I can tell you that I take this book,
and each one of these promises, I read one per day.
I read the scripture, then I read a very
anoointed understanding of the scripture.
You have to understand. It can't be just words.
And then, the prayer is written out,
and you can actually put your children's name in there.
What an investment for your children and grandchildren.
But then, you had a problem with your daughter!
Mike: Yes. Absolutely.
She had a more challenging situation,
because in the sonogram taken of her prior to birth,
the doctor showed us significant evidence
that she had spina bifida.
And, because of problems my wife had in her body,
he said she would probably have cretinism too,
which is a severe retardation.
This particular doctor suggested what he called
an alternative, but by the look on his face
and the tone of his voice, we knew what he was saying.
Sid: You knew what he was talking about.
Did you consider that for one second?
Mike: Not one second,
because no matter what condition that child was in,
we would receive her as a gift from God,
and we would do our best to invest our lives in her life.
Sid: But I have some inside information
as to what happened to his daughter,
and you're going to find out in a minute.
Don't go away, we'll be right back after this word.

We now return to It's Supernatural.

Sid: Oy vey. You have a daughter against impossible odds.
You couldn't even have children.
Mike Shreve and his wife have a daughter.
She's pregnant, and the doctor says
"It looks to me like she's going to have spina bifida and
cretinism. Maybe you should consider something alternative."
Mike and his wife said "No way."
So, what did you do?
Mike: As we walked out of the doctor's office,
my wife said that the Holy Spirit came upon her
and God spoke to her and said we would have a daughter,
and that she would be a dancer.
She would dance for the Lord. So she held onto that word.
Sid: Now that's the opposite of what the doctor is saying.
With spina bifida, she's not going to be a dancer.
Mike: Yeah, there's no way she could've been a dancer.
In fact, she probably would've been in a wheelchair
and not been able to walk.
So God said "Your daughter will be a dancer."
If that wasn't enough, when we got to the car,
she turned on the radio, and the first song that came on
was that beautiful song "I Hope You Dance."
She took that as an absolute confirmation from God.
When she went home, she was studying the Word,
and just praying over this unborn child.
Sid: But what do you do with a doctor's report like that?
Mike: Well, it was very disconcerting,
but she began to pray Psalm 138:8. That verse says
"The Lord will perfect that which concerns me."
She laid hands on her stomach every day,
and she would do two things. She would say
"Child, you concern me,
so I believe God is going to make you perfect."
Then she would sing that song over her, "I Hope You Dance."
That was kind of a ritual, not only once,
but many times a day.
Later on, when Destiny Hope...

We named her Destiny Hope as a prophetic way of opposing what had been spoken over her. Instead of being hopeless, you have hope, and you have a destiny.

Sid: You did what God says to do.

He called things that are not as if they were.

Mike: Yes, and I believe God gave us those names for her.

We prayed very seriously about it.

Then when she was born, the doctor did not know, really, what my wife had been claiming for months.

As she came forth from the womb, somewhat anxiously she said "Doctor, how does she look?"

His words simply were "She's perfect."

The very word she claimed over her for months was realized and fulfilled.

Sid, we've had a battle of intercession over both of our children.

Sid: Tell me about your daughter's dancing.

Mike: From a natural standpoint, she never would've danced had that been true, but then God gave her the miracle.

Sid: You were singing that over her, your wife.

Mike: From the age of 3 onwards, she had this natural proclivity toward dance.

In fact, I would buy her these videos of kids singing Christian songs and dancing along with it, and it became her favorite thing to do.

For hours, she would stand in front of the TV and mimic their gestures and movements.

She could dance so well at an early age that at the age of 5, 6, and 7 she was dancing with Christian dance troops made up mostly of 16, 17, and 18 year olds, and could do just as well if not better than most of them, sometimes.

God gave her that gift of dance, and that was a prophetic declaration over her.

But you know, there's a promise.

We're talking about the 65 promises

God has given our offspring.

Sid, I highlight one in the book that I want to read now because it ties in so well with my daughter's miracle.

Sid: I'm glad it's your book. I wouldn't give you mine.

Mike: It's Psalm 139:13-16, where it says...

In other words, the spine was written.

All the parts she needed in her body,

God wrote it, as well as...

God mapped out her destiny, and God was involved in her formation in the womb.

I counsel parents, if you're having a struggle during pregnancy, claim Psalm 139.

That's one of the 65 promises given to believers that your children will be fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderfully made!

I believe that's a promise we should claim boldly.

Not just pleading with God, but boldly affirming His word.

Sid: You know what I can envision?

A mother or father, or grandmother or grandfather,
takes this, writes their child or grandchild's name
in each prayer as you instruct.

Then in the back, you have a little diary,
the family vision statement, and personal confessions,
and memorable happenings.

Can you picture ten years from today,
twenty years from today, giving this to that child?

Mike: What an awesome gift.

I encourage parents to get one for each child they have.

Sid: And then, your son,
speaking of your daughter dancing
when she wasn't supposed to even be able to walk,
your son starts walking, but he's walking on his toes.

Mike: That's right. He was a toe walker
until he was about 7 or 8 years old.
Constantly. He never walked flat footed.

We were very concerned for him.
We prayed, but we did not pray our way through
to a miracle for all those years. For some reason,
we just didn't get to that level of fighting faith
necessary to get a miracle.

We took him to a hospital in Atlanta Georgia
that's especially geared toward helping young people
of this problem area.

The doctor told me what would probably have to be done
is to clip the tendons in his heel.

He said it's a very chancy thing.

It could grow back better and longer,
where it wouldn't be such a problem for him to walk.
Then again, he could be immobilized
the rest of his life from it.

Sid: What a predicament!

What would you do if you had such a predicament?

Let's find out what Mike did.

Don't go away, we'll be right back after this word.

We'll be right back to It's Supernatural.

We now return to It's Supernatural.

Sid: Sid Roth here with Mike Shreve.
So what happens when the doctor says...
You bring your son who, all he can do is walk on his toes,
well we can have surgery. However, there's a possibility
that we could damage him permanently,
much worse than walking on his toes.
So Mike, what did you decide to do after seeing this doctor?

Mike: I didn't want to take that chance with my son,
especially knowing that I serve
the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob,
and with Him, all things are possible.
We walked out of this huge hospital complex,
and as we walked toward our car,
I heard the audible voice of God.

I believe they helped us to the degree they could,
so I'm not speaking critically of them,
but I heard God say "Leave this place,
and don't ever come back."

I knew I was not supposed to pursue that as an alternative.
A few weeks later, we were in a big convention,
and I brought my son up. Two other ministers,
Spirit filled ministers who believed in healing and miracles,
prayed with me over my son for about 20 minutes.
We claimed the healing scriptures, where God said
"I Am the Lord who heals you.

I will remove all evil disease from you."

We went through all of those promises,
and my son was healed instantly.
The next day, he started walking flat footed,
and he's never walked on his toes since.

I'm so glad I want God's say, instead of man's way.

Sid: So you know from personal experience,
if there's a true prophecy from God,
you can war or fight over your children.

And of course, the truest prophecy from God is His Word.

Mike: That's absolutely right.

Sid: You can fight and war over your children
with the truest Word from God,
which is the written Word of God.

Why did you write that book?

Mike: I wrote the book because
I was searching for promises to pray
and to continue interceding over my own children.
In a general sense I'd prayed the promises of God
over my children for years, but I began to notice
there were specific things God said He would do for them.
My spirit got eagle wings, because instead of pleading
with God to move for my son and my daughter,
I was now affirming God's Word and saying
"You've already promised this.

I don't have to beg You to do it, it's going to come to pass."

Sid: You know what I'm reminded of? The scripture
that says "Can two walk together unless they be agreed?"

You started agreeing with what God said was His will.
Mike: And that's the most powerful way to pray.
I believe that's what James called "the prayer of faith."
The prayer of faith is affirming what God has already declared.
For instance, Isaiah 49:25. God said
"I will contend with him who contends with you,
and I will save your children."
See, whether it was demonic opposition
or just something that happened in the womb,
the enemy was contending with our family
from the very start to prevent us from bringing seed
into the world that would serve God.
But God said "I'll fight the one that's fighting you.
I'll fight the Devil. I'll fight the spirits of infirmity
that have come against your family.
I will save your children." That's a definite.
So you can begin to affirm that and declare that.
I call it "declaring the decree."
If you read Psalm 2, there's a verse in there
where the Messiah - it's actually a Messianic psalm -
he says "I will declare the decree:
Thou art My Son. This day have I begotten Thee."
I noticed that recently.
A decree is an utterance a king makes to establish Law,
but that decree needs to be declared throughout the land
in order for it to be established.
Sid: And it's so important to say it out loud.
Mike: Yes, absolutely.
Sid: You know what I've found lately?
Reading God's Word out loud is more powerful
than reading it to myself, for that same reason.
Mike: There's a spirit of revelation that comes upon you.
I began to declare these decrees.
Another powerful passage of scripture is Deuteronomy 7:9,
where it says that He is the faithful God who keeps
covenant and mercy with them that love Him
to a thousand generation.
A generation is probably 40 years long.
There is some controversy on that in scripture,
but probably it's 40 years long.
Sid: That's long enough.
Mike: Because God is promising 40,000 years from now...
A thousand generations, times 40.
40,000 years from now, there's going to be people
walking around blessed - if we had that much time.
I don't believe we have that much time,
but it was God's way of emphasizing the power
of generational blessing.
He said 40,000 years from now,
there will be people walking around blessed,
under the covenant of God, and under a reservoir
of His mercy, to bring restoration to their life,
just because of your walk with God.
When they had long ago forgotten you were in the family line,
there would still be a lingering blessing
that would pass down through the family.
There's so many fantastic promises.

I believe one of my favorites is Isaiah 54:13,
where God said "All your children shall be taught by the Lord,
and great shall be the peace of your children."

I depend on that, because there's only so much
we can do as parents to instruct our children
concerning what they should do in life.

But it becomes just a mental thing,
just knowledge stored up in them,
unless they have a direct revelation from God themselves.
God did that for my son too.

At the age of 4, he came down from his bedroom
one morning and made the most amazing announcement.

He said "Mommy, Daddy, I died in my sleep
and went to heaven last night and met with Jesus,
and He showed me around and talked to me."

Sid: That's amazing. He died.

How would you like your child to say that?

Now he didn't really die,
but in his dreams he died and went to heaven.

Was there any way of you figuring out whether it was
just too much pizza, or he really had an encounter?

Mike: Well, I really believe he had an encounter with God,
because he began to tell us what Jesus told him.

Jesus had given him personal instruction.

One thing, He told him not to watch bad television,
and secondly, He told him to have compassion for all people.

He didn't even know what the word "compassion" meant.

We had to really explain to him what compassion was.

He'd never used that word before.

The very fact he used a word he'd never used before,
and it had relevance and real meaning to it,
convinced us he'd had a genuine visionary experience.

Which is Acts 2:17 right there.

Another promise that I highlight in the book,
where it says "'In the last days', sayeth God,

'I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh.'"

And God didn't just say you'll prophesy,

He said "Your sons and daughters shall prophesy,

and your young men shall see visions,

and your old men shall dream dreams."

So with the outpouring of the Holy Spirit
in the New Covenant era, God does not do away with
the transfer of blessing to the next generation.

That's not just an Old Covenant situation,
that is a pattern in the way God does things.

If parents walk with God,

even if just one member of a household walks with God,
if the wife walks with God...

First Corinthians 7:14 says that the unbelieving husband
is sanctified by the believing wife,

therefore your children are holy and not unclean.

Which, incidentally, is another promise in the book.

My child is holy,

because First Corinthians 7:14 declares that he is holy.

Even if I was married to an unbeliever, that's still the case.

Sid: Listen. Mike, there's a problem.

People want multiple copies of this book, one for

every child, one for every grandchild, to pray for them.
But in just a minute or two, until they get their book,
would you pray a prayer over their children right now?

Mike: Absolutely, absolutely.

I know this is dear to your heart,
and I know this is important to you. Your children are
the thing many of you are most concerned about.
I'm going to claim a promise for those that are out in darkness.
And for those children that are walking in the truth,
we'll claim promises for them too.

Let's pray over your children right now.

Wherever you're at, just bow your head or lift your hands,
however you want to approach God, and let's pray.

Father, in the name of Jesus,
we consecrate and dedicate these children to You,
that are being offered up to You all around the globe
in many nations right now.

I declare over the lives of those children that are backslidden,
that Jeremiah 31:17 will come to pass for these concerned parents,
where You said "There is hope in thine end

that thy children shall return again to their own border."

These parents have given boundaries of the truth
to their children, that maybe they've gone outside of.

But "There is hope in thine end

that thy children shall return to their own border."

I claim that for you. I claim the promise of God
in Deuteronomy 30, where God said

"I set before you blessing and cursing, life and death.

Therefore choose life, that both you and your offspring may live."

There's a lot of death dealing forces in this world, Lord,

but I claim that none of them will have power

over the children being lifted up to You right now.

I choose life,

and these parents that are listening today choose life,

the life of God that brings love and joy and peace

and righteousness into our lives. I claim it.

Sid: Mike, I'm hearing that same scripture

that Mike prayed earlier for his daughter.

"The Lord will perfect that which concerns you."

It's going to be perfect. It's going to be ok!

Yes, the Lord will perfect it.

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
